

Privacy Policy

What we collect

If you engage People First Dorset's services we may store your personal data such as your name, address, contact details and any personal information obtained from you or provided to us that is relevant to deliver our services.

Website Cookies

Our website uses cookies to help us improve the users experience while visiting the website.

Cookies are small files saved to the user's computers hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website.

Users accessing the website are advised that if they wish to deny the use and saving of cookies from this website on to their computers hard drive they should take necessary steps within their web browsers security settings to block all cookies from this website and its external serving vendors or use the cookie control system if available upon their first visit.

Adverts and Sponsored Links

Contact and Communication with us

We will never ask for user passwords or personal details on social media platforms. Users are advised to conduct themselves appropriately when engaging with us on social media.
